Unapologetically unconventional, Yuho experiments with brewing components and techniques to produce sake that have a wild, gamey characteristic with pronounced acidity and remarkable texture.

Miho Fujita and Toji Yokomichi-san do not follow traditional brewing methods and brew the sake that they enjoy drinking.

📍 Kumamoto, Japan

Yuri Honda represents the next generation of leadership at Chiyonosono, following in her father's footsteps as the brewery's future president.

Chiyonosono was the first brewery to stop adding distilled alcohol to its sake after the rice shortages of World War II, setting the stage for the Junmai style we know and love today.
