HARVEST DETAILS: The vineyards are located in Luján de Cuyo, in the coldest part of Agrelo and Perdriel. The deep soil is a sandy-clay texture with the presence of large boulders originally from the Mendoza River thousands of years ago.

- A bright and clean Rosé with aromas of fresh red fruits like cherry and strawberry with subtle notes of spice and pepper.
- The palate is balanced and medium-bodied.
- Try with: strawberry topped waffles, asparagus-cheese tartines or mushroom quiche.

A high-elevation desert, Mendoza has long sunny days, cold nights, low humidity, and natural irrigation from glacial snowmelt from the Andes Mountains. Bodini wines are fresh, fruit-forward, and a great introduction to Malbec.
