TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

- Red and black fruit aromas like ripe plums and cherries, with mild spicy hints of black pepper and vanilla.
- In the mouth is fresh and complex, with an elegant and persistent finish.

Casarena was built in 1937 and sits in the heartland of Mendoza's historic winemaking region, Lujan de Cuyo. Casarena's single vineyard wines make for unique culinary pairings that will elevate any dining experience.

Winemaker Martina Galeano and Agronomist Pablo Ceverino are two of the best young talents in Argentine wine. The team continues to conduct ongoing intensive soil research on their vineyard sites that are unlike any other terroir found in Lujan de Cuyo.
