AGING: The wine goes through malolactic fermentation and is unoaked to retain the pure flavors of the grapes.

HARVEST DETAILS: The vineyards are located in Luján de Cuyo and Maipu with soil that is made up of clay and loam soil. The grapes are hand harvested.

TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

- Fruit and spice on the palate balanced by notes of fresh fruits like plums and blackberries.
- It is ripe in the mouth with soft, round tannins and a long finish.
