WINEMAKING DETAILS

VARIETAL: 45% Carignan, 35% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot REGION: Maule/Itata/Colchagua AVG. ELEVATION: 325 AVG. AGE OF VINES: 33 PH: 3.36 ALCOHOL: 14 SIZE: 12/750ml UPC: 835603002669

AGING: The components are vinified, separated, and aged for 28 months in third and fourth use French neutral oak, then filtered lightly before bottling.

HARVEST DETAILS: The Carignan and Cabernet Franc are from old vines in Maule Valley, the Cabernet Sauvignon is from Itata, Petit Verdot is from Colchagua.

TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

- Bright yet brooding. Up front, it is all fresh and expressive red berries.
- On the palate, you find touches of herbs and cocoa. It finished with bright cherry and vivacity.
- Try With: grilled red meats and slow-cooked short ribs.





WINERY OVERVIEW

Felipe started PS Garcia in 2006. After working for larger wineries, he made his first independent wine as a declaration of what he considers true "Chilean" wine. Inspired at first by old-vine Carignan from Maule, he since have started two of Chile's most influential small producer movements today: MOVI (Movement of Independent Vintners) and VIGNO (Vignadores de Carignan).
