HARVEST DETAILS: This 100% Carignan Vigno wine is sourced from two blocks of the Crucecillas vineyard planted in 1958 that are vinified separately.

TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

- A very aromatic wine with distinctive nose of dark berries, intense flowers, and a little tar.
- The blackberry and spices come out when you taste it, along with a little pepperiness. It is earthy and medium-bodied, giving an Old World impression.
- Try With: meat casserole, grilled salmon, or some stews.

WINERY OVERVIEW

Felipe started PS Garcia in 2006. After working for larger wineries, he made his first independent wine as a declaration of what he considers true “Chilean” wine.

Inspired at first by old-vine Carignan from Maule, he since have started two of Chile’s most influential small producer movements today: MOVI (Movement of Independent Vintners) and VIGNO (Vignadores de Carignan).
