## WINEMAKING DETAILS

**VARIETAL:** 50% Grenache, 50% Syrah **PH:** 3.6  
**REGION:** Southern Rhone, France **ALCOHOL:** 14.5  
**AVG. ELEVATION:** 1,312 **SIZE:** 12/750ml  
**AVG. AGE OF VINES:** 40 **UPC:** 835603003710

**AGING:** Grenache maceration is fairly short and slightly longer for the Syrah to obtain the right tannins. Aged in concrete for 1 year before bottling.

**HARVEST DETAILS:** Manual harvest with partial destemming to avoid green tannins.

**TERROIR:** Soils of clay & limestone

## TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

- Intense garnet color. Aromas of black cherry, blueberry and chocolate.
- Great balance between freshness and power with finessed tannins.
- Pair with game meats, roasted lamb, bbq pork or grilled portabella mushrooms.

## WINERY OVERVIEW

Val des Rois translates to “Valley of the King” and is nestled in the hills outside of Valréas in Southern Rhône. Valréas is one of the rare areas in the south producing a fresh style of Côtes du Rhône Villages. The pure limestone slopes are found among the rolling hills, peaking at over 1300 feet elevation. Through a combination of organic farming and cool climate fruit, Val des Rois wines reflect balance and purity at the highest caliber.
